1) The victory of Donald Trump has tolled the knee of a new era, with racist, islamophobic and against women's rights laws in the offing. Moreover, this outcome stirred controversy because it was more or less unexpected, but also because of the worldwide impact of Donald Trump's decisions.

We can ask ourselves : What interpretations may be given for Donald Trump's victory according to the author ?



It was clear that Donald Trump was mostly cheered by the white working class because he succeeded in understanding their matters and what they wanted to hear. Many of his voters felt resentment out of the loss of their coal jobs. For them, it was their hobby horse with no doubt, the only reason of their unhappiness. Trump promised to bring them back and to end the domination of liberal elites. Up against him, the health care and higher minimum wages offered by Hillary Clinton weren't as reducing, even if Obama Care highly reduced the number of uninsured in the most affected areas where they were part of.

With hindsight, these voters may understand that Donald Trump's promises were unreliable but it will be too late. The economist also accuses news media of focussing in Mrs Clinton's emails scandal instead of policy issues. In fact, Democrats' policies were a goose with golden eggs for the white working class, but ^{the} media failed to convey that. Lies win over long-term benefits and it is likely somebody will face a setback.

2) After American election and Brexit, many fear the upcoming results of French election, as the likely victory of far-right would confirm that acceptance and love towards others are on tenterhooks. Furthermore, it seems that people don't trust the state and its decisions anymore, so we can ask ourselves: Can an anti-establishment parallel be drawn between American election and Brexit?



Both events encounter a high rate of abstention, which showed a reluctance towards both candidates in America, but above all, people feel that their individual vote doesn't matter anymore. This lack of confidence in the democratic system calls it into question. Young people feel ousted by seniors, who have the right to decide for their future but don't have much to lose as their time is running out. Seniors feel overwhelmed by globalization, finance, notions that they don't really understand except that it is certainly somehow a treat.

In addition, both countries were affected by crisis and liberalization. The working class suffers from foreign competition and desindus-

trialization, so, as consequence, Brexit and the protectionism defended by Trump seemed to be a silver lining. Moreover, people are likely to think that it is all because of the State which want to defend the upper class in their backs. Electing a new president like Trump who is off the beaten track, or leave the EU, then seemed to be risky choices but people are willing to make them at this point.



Nevertheless, it is too soon to see if it was worth it, on the one hand, Trump is unpredictable and on the other hand, Britain decided to leave the nest to fly with its own wings but in both cases, the fall may be harsh.
