Comments

Château Berliquet 2018 is a wine of character. Its attack is warm and dominated by yellow stone fruit, such as ripe apricots and peaches with fine, delicate flesh. On the palate, the wine is long and taut with a solid minerality running throughout. Fresh notes of cedar come through in the third movement. This sappy imprint reveals the personality of the cru. A play of chiaroscuro layers, with a fascinating contrast and evolution
