Expressing needs / Milaza filan-javatra

Mampiasa verb "to need"

- I **need** two eggs and some flour. / Mila atody roa sy lafarinina aho.
- Everyone **needs** love and care. / Mila fitiavana sy fikarakarana ny olona rehetra.
- You **need** someone to teach you how to manage this device. / Mila olona ianao hampianatra anao hifehy an'io fitaovana io.
- You **need** to find a job fast. / Mila mitady asa haingana ianao.

Mampiasa verb "to require"

- The job **requires** a good knowledge of English and French. / Mitaky fahaizana teny Anglisy sy Frantsay ilay asa.
- We **require** more help to finish the project. / Mila fanampiana bebe kokoa izahay mba hamitana ilay tetik'asa.
- Learning a foreign language **requires** constant practice. / Mila ezaka hatrany ny fianarana teny vahiny.

Mampiasa verb "to want"

- I **want** some water to wet the clothes before ironing them. / Mila rano aho handemako ny akanjo alohan'ny hipasohako azy.
- The clients **want** more details about the services. / Mila fanazavana misimisy mahakasika ny asa ireo mpanjifa.
- The baby **wants** a toy to pass time. / Mila kilalao ilay zazakely mba handaniany fotoana.

Ankoatra ireo verbs izay hita etsy ambony, dia misy ihany koa ireo fomba fiteny hafa hanehoana filàna zavatra.

- I'm **in need of** money. / Mila vola aho.
- Many people are **in need of** a house. / Be dia be ny olona mila trano.
- **What I need is** something like this. / Zavatra tahaka ity no ilaiko.
- **What the kids need is** to go to the beach to hang out. / Handeha hilalao any amin'ny torapasika no ilain'ny ankizy.
- **What works for me is** to take a walk by the river. / Mandehaneha eny amoron-drano izao no mety amiko.
- **What works for him is** to stick around the house and doing nothing. / Mijanonjanona ao an-trano izao no mety aminy dia tsy manao na inona na inona.
- **I need it to be done** quickly, please. / Mba ilaiko ho vita haingana lay izy, azafady.
