Presented since 1999, the exhibition-auction *Parle-moi d'amour* has become a major flagship event of the Montreal arts community and the main fundraiser of the organization Les Impatients. It is a silent auction where are presented and sold 300 artworks from workshop participants, professional artists and arts collectors. A committee made of professionals from the art community selects about 30 works to be part of the closing event's live auction. The auction's profits allow the organization to support and develop their creative workshops.
