## **HEALTH INSURANCE**

If I am Ukrainian, but I study in Poland, so I can make the private health insurance?

It's up to you, you can take out a private health insurance for the duration of your stay or you can take out the French health insurance at your arrival

If I have the Italian National Healthcare Card (with European logo on the card), do I still have to make the procedure for EU students or is it enough to bring the card with me? Thank you

As long as you are covered by the Italian health insurance, you can benefit from the European coverage. You have to apply for it at your local agency, it takes around one month to get it.

I am non-EU citizen but EU student in Germany, will I be eligible for EHIC since I am already insured in Germany under health insurance? I am insured with TK health insurance in Germany?

I encourage you to contact the German health insurance agency in order to check if you can benefit from it now.

Do EU citizens have to present the birth certificate?

It will be required if you apply for CAF (if you are eligible) - (EU and non EU citizens). For students applying for CPAM, they will ask it to you too.

## **OTHERS**

I have a question about visa: I have a Polish visa (EU visa), but now I have to make namely French one, right?

You are right, you need a long stay visa for France. Even if you hold a visa from another European country, you need to hold a French visa. There is one exception: if you hold a EU mobility visa, you do not need a French visa. So please check your visa.

Are we obliged to register ourselves in the municipality of Nice? If yes, how do we do that?

No need to register.

EU mobility visa allows students to work in France?



Yes it is possible to work in the EU. However there is a limited time. You can work up to 964 hours per year only. On your visa, it must be stated "autorise à travailler à titre accessoire" (allows you to work).
