- It is recommended that over-the-counter and prescription medications for all members of the family be carried in a first aid kit ahead of time.Keep the first aid kit in the same location as the emergency kit.
- Make sure there is sufficient pure water and food for everyone in the household.Food products must not be cooked or refrigerated before consumption.Using canned foods requires the use of a manual can opener, which should always be on hand.
