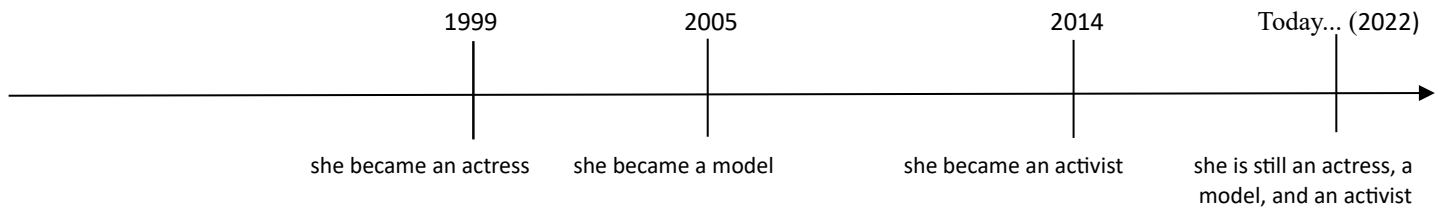


## Emma Watson Present perfect + for / since
