

Formalities to be done before reaching EDHEC

Am I ready to reach France?

PASSPORT / VISA – NON-EU CITIZENS
☐ I have a valid passport,
☐ I got my French student visa,
☐ I have a scanned copy of my passport and my visa in my email box,
\square My passport was stamped by the customs at the airport within the Schengen area.
□ <u>VERY IMPORTANT</u> : I send my visa validation document to InternationalStudentOfficeL@edhec.edu during my first week in France.
MANDATORY STUDENT LIFE CONTRIBUTION (CVEC)
☐ I have finalized my registration and paid the €100 through the required platform.
I must do it before reaching France otherwise my registration at EDHEC will not be validated.
HEALTH INSURANCE • EU citizen
☐ I have a European Health Insurance Card. If I cannot get it, I will take out the French Public Health insurance once in France.
☐ I send a copy to InternationalStudentOfficeL@edhec.edu <u>before August 24th.</u>
■ NON-EU citizen
☐ I have a private health insurance that covers me until the end of September, and I will take out the <u>French</u> <u>Public Health insurance</u> once in France.
\square I send the proof of my registration to the mandatory public health insurance to InternationalStudentOfficeL@edhec.edu as soon as I register.
<u>HOUSING</u>
I have scheduled my check-in appointment with the residence Manager / my landlord In some student residences, NO check-in during weekends and after 5:30pm.
\square Home insurance to bring to the check-in appointment (for the residences TWENTY CAMPUS the insurance is included)
DOCUMENTS TO BRING AT YOUR ARRIVAL ON CAMPUS Also principal birth contificate (for students who need to translate it)
☐ My original birth certificate (for students who need to translate it)
❖ To open a French bank account:
☐ Original passport + 1 copy,
☐ Original student visa + 1 copy, (non-EU citizens only)
\square Copy of my school enrolment letter (the one in French available in MyEdhec – "Administrative documents"),
\square A copy of my home insurance certificate (one-page certificate – not the entire contract).

 Apply before your arrival online – <u>step-by-step HERE</u> (it takes about 10 days to receive the card by post Make sure you write the <u>exact</u> address when registering.
Apply at the agency or on-campus on August 31 st and bring:
☐ Completed form:
o Less than 25yo
o More than 25yo
Please find a step-by-step to help you fill in the form.
☐ Original passport + 1 copy
☐ Original student visa + 1 copy (non-EU citizens only)
☐ Copy of my school enrolment letter (the one in French available in MyEdhec – administrative document section – not the LOE)
☐ Housing proof (your signed lease)
☐ ID picture.
Ilevia will be on-campus on August 31 st - NO CASH — PAYMENT BY BANK CARD ONLY
OTHER DOCUMENTS & FORMALITIES
☐ I bring to France a copy of the original version of my birth certificate <u>AND</u> the official translation* into
French.
☐ If I intend to drive in France, I bring my driving license as well as its official translation*.
*EDHEC ISO has a partnership with a translator agency in Lille named <u>AB Traduction</u> .
