1. Violet + Cam Beige WW2 1:1 (airbrush)



2. First light with Deck Tan (airbrush)



3. First shadow with Cam Beige WW2 (airbrush). Second shadow with Cam Beige WW2 + Violet 1:1



4. Second Light with Ivory (airbrush)



5. Paint with Black all non White parts. Paint de grooves with Violet Ink + Cam Beige WW2 3:1



6. Paint the edges with Ivory. Reserve the White for upper edges and extreme light points.

Guide du manuel de la boîte Opération Black Winds :



First, using an airbrush or a spray paint, prime the model applying a thin layer of black primer. Then, apply two thin layers of grey.



Highlight the face with VMC Sunny Skintone #70.845 by adding it to the base color. To highlight the base color of the armor, just apply VMC White #70.951. Do the same with the outer side of the pants, with a 1:1 mix of VMC Violet #70.960 + VMC White #70.951. Then, paint the inner side of the pants with VMC Medium Sea Grey #70.870.



Paint the base color of each part of the model. Following that, apply several washes to get more definition. The colors used came from the Vallejo Model Color (VMC) and Vallejo Game Color (VGC) ranges.



Paint the straps with VMC Mahogany Brown #70.846, highlighting them with VMC Sunny Skin Tone #70.845. Then, highlight the inner side of the pants with a 1:1 mix of VMC Medium Sea Grey #70.870 + VMC White #70.951.

► Face:

- Base: VMC Cork Brown #70.843.
- Washes: VMC Chocolate Brown #70.872.

► Armor:

- Base: VMC Ivory #70.918.
- Washes: VMC German Cam. Beige WWII #70.821.

► Pants:

- Base: VMC Violet #70.960.
- Washes: VGC Hexed Lichen #72.715.



Apply different tones of VMC Black #70.950 + VMC Medium Sea Grey #70.870 to the edges of the rifle. Apply VMC Black #70.950 to paint the detail of the shield. As a final touch, decorate the base of the model as you prefer and then paint it.
